Eligibility Criteria

- ❖ Members must have alone time in the community sufficient to allow for activity attendance and transportation to and from an activity.
***If the member does not have sufficient enough of alone time, Member must be accompanied by another facilitating adult. ***
- ❖ Members must make their own arrangements for medical and personal care needs during activities.
- ❖ Members must not act in a way that could adversely impact the health and safety of themselves, the public, peers, or attending staff and volunteers.
- ❖ Members must be able to arrange transportation to and from activities or meeting places. BLAST staff and volunteers are not required to provide transportation services.

Code of Conduct

- ❖ Treat others and their property with respect, be polite and courteous.
- ❖ Do not swear, yell, or use language that could be offensive to others.
- ❖ Do not consume or be under the influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs during BLAST activities.
- ❖ Be on time for activities and at transportation meeting locations.
- ❖ Refrain from public displays of affection and inappropriate sexual behavior.
- ❖ Follow the direction of Summit DD staff and activity volunteers.
- ❖ Behave in a manner that gives the public a positive image of Summit DD.
- ❖ Do not behave in a manner that creates a health and safety threat to you or others.
- ❖ If responsible for a guest attendee, ensure he/she follows the code of conduct.

Failure to follow the above code of conduct may result in a special team meeting to discuss the violations with the potential consequence of being suspended from attending future BLAST activities or losing BLAST membership rights.

BLAST ACTIVITIES – GENERAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Quarterly schedules are mailed and/or emailed to BLAST members based on contact information on the BLAST membership/registration form. A full schedule of activities is also listed at www.summitdd.org. You may also ask to be invited to the BLAST Facebook Group for updates. Quarterly newsletters will also be mailed to each member.
- ❖ The cost of BLAST activities are the responsibility of members and their guest wishing to attend the activity and may be required to be paid in advance as part of an RSVP requirement.
- ❖ **Please do not mail cash with your RSVP. If you cannot send a check, please contact one of the Blast Advisors to RSVP and arrange payment.**
- ❖ ***Returned Checks Policy: If we receive a returned check, the participant will have to pay for activities with cash for the rest of the year.***
- ❖ Transportation to and from activities or meeting places is the responsibility of attendees.
- ❖ Many activities have a limit of attendees based on staff availability and/or capacity of activity facility in which case RSVPs are required and taken on a first come first paid/served basis.
- ❖ Individuals who RSVP after the attendance limit is reached will be placed on a space-available list by the date the RSVP is received. If cancellations occur, the space-available list will be used to fill vacancies.
- ❖ In some instances activities may be open to guests on a space available basis with the person served being responsible for the cost and conduct of the guest. An RSVP must indicate if the person-served will be accompanied.
